Resolution 481 – A Resolution to Place the Impositions of Hotel and Motel Tax on the Election Ballot for the City of Harpers Ferry, Iowa


Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Diggins, Riha, Kaepfel, Garin, Barta. Noes: None. Motion was carried.
